

### I AM A STUDENT FROM A MEMBER STATE OF THE EUROPEAN UNION

The higher education studies offered at ARTS<sup>2</sup> are accessible **after passing an entrance examination in the chosen option**, which will take place from **1 to 20 September**, 2014. The detailed calendar is posted at school and published on the school's website: <a href="www.artsaucarre.be">www.artsaucarre.be</a>. However, some admissions are possible until 15 October 2014 (continuation courses, reorientation, or else)

# TO ACCESS THE FIRST YEAR (BAC 1), I MUST BE A HOLDER OF:

- A certified copy of the ministerial decision recognizing the equivalence for Upper Secondary Education, or evidence that an application file has been submitted in order to get that equivalence;
- A citizenship certificate

TO DIRECTLY ACCESS THE BACHELOR'S DEGREE SECOND (BAC 2) OR THIRD (BAC 3) YEAR OR THE MASTER'S DEGREE, I must be a holder or beneficiary of a:

- First Prize given by a Royal Conservatory of the French Community (Communauté française) of Belgium;
- Diploma likened to the first bachelor's year (BAC 1) in plastic arts, music or theatre, or speech;
- Diploma delivered by a higher education school of arts outside of the French Community of Belgium, recognized as equivalent to a 1<sup>st</sup> degree cycle by the ad hoc Commission (after submitting an application file for equivalence);
- Considerable artistic, personal ou professional experience (application file to be submitted to ARTS<sup>2</sup>'s school management).
- Diploma recognising a 1st degree cycle in a Higher Education institution, as long as the studies are related to the Master's Degree applied for at ARTS<sup>2</sup>.

In the latter two cases, <u>an evaluation must be taken</u>. The programme, dates and times of the test are identical to the entrance examination in the chosen subject.

In case I enter a request for exemption or continuation courses, I should provide the school with:

- An application letter;
- Copies certified by a Belgian authority (Belgian Ambassy, Consulate or municipal administration) for the following documents:
  - 1. Higher artistic education diploma(s);
  - 2. Honours or grades obtained for the exams taken during each year of study;
  - 3. Official programmes, detailed year by year, of the completed higher education studies, and including a brief description and the number of hours for each class taken;

Should these documents be written in any other language than French, the Belgian authorities demand that they are accompanied by a French translation, made by a sworn translator in Belgium or by a Belgian Ambassy or Consulate.

# I CAN REGISTER

From Tuesday 1 July to Friday 11 July and from Monday 18 August until the last business day preceding the entrance examination in the chosen option, with the registration form provided by the school's secretariat, located rue de Nimy 7 in Mons, <a href="mailto:info@artsaucarre.be">info@artsaucarre.be</a> and which can be downloaded on the website www.artsaucarre.be.

## I HAVE TO PROVIDE THE FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS FOR ADMINISTRATIVE PURPOSES

- 1. A dated and signed registration form;
- 2. A double-sided copy of my national identity card;
- 3. An evidence of membership in a private health insurance (mutuelle);
- 4. An official or certified copy of birth certificate;



- 5. Two ID photos with my first name, LAST NAME, name of the chosen option on the back of the photo;
- 6. For students under 18 years old, a written permission from the head of the family;
- 7. A certified true copy of the certificate of Further Secondary Education OR an official equivalence OR an original provisional document for the students who finished their secondary education in June 2014;
- 8. For musicians and actors: the programme of the entrance examination.

### NOTES:

1. I want to register for undergraduate degree program (Bachelor's Degree) by submitting an application file for recognition of the equivalence of secondary school leaving certificate.

Once I am notified of the decision to be admitted, I will submit an equivalence application file within 5 days. All the information is available on www.equivalences.cfwb.be.

We nevertheless advise you to introduce the application file before being admitted.

I must join a certified copy of the 1st cycle degree obtained in a Belgian institution or a certified copy of the Belgian equivalence for the 1<sup>st</sup> degree cycle obtained outside Belgium.

I want to register for a Didactic Master's Degree ou for classes leading to the Aggregation of secondary school teaching and I am not a holder of a diploma delivered by the French Community, Walonia Brussels Federation: I must success a French language test (level C1 in the Common European Framework), which will be organized during the academic year.
