Students mobility constitutes the main objective of our ERASMUS+ project. Arts<sup>2</sup> does not sign bilateral agreements unless they open the possibility for inbound and outbound student mobility. All bilateral agreements are based on fair reciprocity of exchanges.

## APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

- Applications for mobility must be submitted exclusively by Email to Erasmus@artsaucarre.be. No paper applications will be accepted.
- All applications must be sent by the international Relations Department of the home institution on behalf of the student.
- **Deadlines for student mobility applications**
  - May 15<sup>th</sup> for Autumn term
  - November 1<sup>st</sup> for Spring term
- **Application files must contain (.pdf or .doc) :**
  - An Erasmus+ Student Application form in French or English Signed and stamped by the home institution
  - A filled Erasmus+ Learning Agreement with desired courses and ECTS credit values
  - A Curriculum Vitae in French or English
  - A motivation letter in French or English
  - A recommendation letter signed by the main teacher at the home institution
  - *For musicians*, min 10 minutes recordings (via weblink\*)
  - *For composers*, 1 or 2 music scores with recording (via weblink\*)
  - *For actors*, ± 10 minutes of recording (via weblink\*)
  - *For visual arts*, portfolio of artistic realisations
  - A copy of passport or national ID card
  - A picture (jpeg or png format)

## LANGUAGE REQUIREMENTS

- French is the only teaching language for group classes and a minimum B1 level is expected prior to arrival.
- At the teacher's discretion, other languages may be agreed upon between the student and the teacher for individual tuition.
- Arts<sup>2</sup> offers the possibility to register for free French classes (56 hours per term during evenings) (5 ECTS credits per term). This option must appear as a separate line in the Learning Agreement and must be requested at the time of application.
