

Information about the scholarship granted to students from the European Union by the Direction des of the Wallonia-Brussels Federation

Students from a European Union country can apply, even if they are not resident in Belgium and even if their parents do not work in Belgium.

They are treated in the same way as Belgian students (see nationality conditions) and are subject to the same income ceiling rules.

However, it is not possible to cumulate these benefits if they receive a grant from their country of origin.

Example: a French student cannot receive a French grant from the CROUS and at the same time a Belgian grant from the DAPE.

Further information via the social worker. Applications must be submitted before **31 October:**

if you have a Belgian resident identity card, with a Belgian national registration number and a PIN code

to be sent by registered mail!

To be attached to your application absolutely:

1. If you are domiciled in your country of origin: a document issued by your local council which attests to the identity of the persons belonging to your family at the same address as you (equivalent to the household composition in Belgium)
2. The tax notice for the year of income in 2020 (for all persons living at the same address)
3. A tax notice for the 2020 property tax if you or your parents own your home
4. A bank statement with IBAN and BIC (student's account)
5. A certificate of enrolment at the Ecole Supérieure des Arts in 2022-2023
6. A copy of your lease if you have accommodation in Belgium
7. A copy of your school pass for public transport

Remarks :

- In the form, you are asked for your national registration number. As you do not have one in Belgium, you do not need anything. You do not have one in Belgium, you do not need to indicate anything.
- Don't forget to sign and date your application and send it back as soon as possible and before 31 October 2022, by registered post.
- You must also provide the acknowledgement of receipt to the school's finance department.
