

TUITION FEES

"MINERVAL"

- Annual tuition fees (DI) for Belgian students or students from an EU Member State, enrolled in a Bachelor's or Master's programme: 500€
- Annual tuition fees (DI) for students from non-EU countries enrolled in Bachelor's or Master's programme:

500€ + mandatory additional contribution of 4175€*

* Students who are nationals of a country outside the European Union are exempt from this additional contribution if their country is on the list of Least Developed Countries (LDCs), if they are graduates of secondary education organised or subsidised by the Wallonia-Brussels Federation, or if they are recipients of a Wallonia-Brussels International (WBI) scholarship.

As an exception, students who are already enrolled and have paid a specific enrolment fee (DIS) of 1487€ (Bachelor's) or 1984€ (Master's) in addition to the 500€ registration fee for the 2024-25 academic year, may continue to benefit from these former amounts in 2025-26, provided they remain in the same programme and cycle. – Bachelor's degree (former

- Master's degree (former student 2024-25): DI 500€ + DIS 1984€

STUDENT CARD



You may retrieve your ARTS² student card from any of the administrative departments of the four training areas at the beginning of the academic year in November (for Dance, student cards will be distributed in Charleroi).

You should know that in order for your card to be printed, you need to meet the following three requirements:

- Having paid at least the deposit
- Having signed your PAE (programme annuel d'études, annual study programme)
- Having filled in your administrative file at the secretariat in charge of students (a file is considered complete when all the documents have been handed in)

If you do not fulfil these three conditions, your card will not be printed. We ask you to ensure you fulfil all three conditions before you contact us.

Your student card will give you access to various ARTS² services (canteen, photocopies, libraries...). It will also enable you to benefit from reduced prices and even free entry on a daily basis (to cinemas, museums, exhibitions, concerts, plays...).

Moreover, thanks to your card, you will be able to benefit from the services offered by the *Pôle hainuyer* (see p.28-29), including access to all the libraries of the member institutions; all you need to do is show your card.

While you wait for your card to be printed, do not hesitate to ask the secretariat in charge of students for a certification of enrolment at ARTS² which will guarantee you the same services.

SOCIAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT

ACADEMIC ADVISOR & PAE

As specified in the title, the academic advisor advises students on their academic career. Common questions include: which courses should I attend, which past courses or professional experiences could bring added value to my academic career, how can I retrain or complete my training, what would happen if I were to fail, etc.

One of the academic advisor's main tasks is to supervise the drafting (creation) **OF THE ANNUAL STUDENT**

PROGRAMME (PAE).

The **PAE** is the personalised list of courses that each student receives at the beginning of the academic year. It specifies the learning/training activities which need to be attended and on which the student will be assessed. In order for the enrolment to be validated, the student needs to read his/her PAE and sign it at the secretariat.

When should I sign the PAE?

You will receive an e-mail (sent to your firstname.surname @etu.artsaucarre.be address) inviting you to come and sign your PAE at the start of the academic year. In order for your enrolment to be effective, the secretariat must have your signed PAE

Please note that your **PAE** is unmodifiable thereafter (except in special cases).

Your PAE will be an essential document throughout your time with us: you have no choice but to take part in all the activities specified on the document as each course unit which appears on it will be subject to deliberation at the end of the academic year, which will confirm you have passed, or not.

The academic advisor is there to help you, should you wish to reduce the number of courses you are attending, anticipate credits or retrain during your time with us. However, you should be aware of the fact that any change is subject to specific conditions and strict deadlines which you will find in our **school rules** on our website:

Teachers may also ask the academic advisor to act as a mediator to help them find solutions to specific problems which some students face in their courses.

QUALITY COORDINATION

As is the case with each higher education art school (ESA) in the Wallonia-Brussels Federation (FWB or Fédération Wallonie-Bruxelles), ARTS's quality coordination team works hand in hand with the AEQES (agence d'évaluation de la qualité de l'enseignement supérieur), an agency in charge of quality control in higher education institutions. For more information, please visit: www.aeqes.be).

The main objectives of the process are :

- Improving the training programmes offered by the institutions.
- Submitting proposals to politicians in order to improve the quality of higher education.
- Instilling a "quality" culture within each institution.

In order to achieve these objectives, the quality coordination team hands in a **report** for every training area, every five years, which, in turn, leads to a visit by independent

external experts whose thoughts give rise to a **quality action plan** involving various work groups made up of members of the ARTS² community (teachers, students, administration and management personnel).

In order to help us improve the quality of our institution, we invite you to discover our online consultation form which will enable you to voice any comments or useful suggestions (regarding infrastructure, logistics, organisation, teaching methods, well-being...). You will be asked for your e-mail address in order for us to provide you with a follow-up.

INTERNATIONAL RELATIONS

ARTS², whose members signed the **Erasmus Charter**, encourages the mobility of students, teachers and its administrative personnel.

Every year, the school warmly welcomes students aiming to perfect their skills for part (one "quadrimestre") of or the whole (two "quadrimestres") academic year. A "quadrimestre" corresponds to a four-month period.

Furthermore, ARTS² is currently developing a network of international partnerships outside the EU. In 2015-2016, for instance, international exchanges with Kindai University (Osaka, Japan) and the University of Antioquia (Medellin, Colombia) took place.

SCHOOL COMMITTEES AND COUNCIL

CGP CONSEIL DE GESTION PÉDAGOGIQUE

(committee in charge of educational management/board of managers)

This committee is presided over by the head of the arts college: Michel Stockhem, with the head of Visual Arts, Dance and Drama at his side.

It is made up of members of the teaching, administrative and maintenance staff, as well as students, all of whom are elected. It includes union representatives. The government delegate commissioner also sits there. Its mission is to draft and define, amongst other things, the artistic and educational project (PPA, Projet Pédagogique et Artistique), as well as the specific school rules (RPE, Règlement Particulier des Études).

It is consulted by the Ministry of Education, the Wallonia-Brussels public governing body WBE (Wallonie Bruxelles Enseignement) also known as Pouvoir Organisateur (PO) for any questions relating to education or concerning the use of educational aids or the posting of staff members (teachers and administrative and maintenance staff).

CD CONSEIL DE DOMAINE

(training area committee)

This committee is presided over by the area head.

It is made up of members of the teaching personnel of the given area, and students who have enrolled in this area, all of whom are elected.

It is a consultative committee where questions relating to education and the organisation of the area are discussed.

CO CONSEIL D'OPTION

(specialisation committee)

This committee makes suggestions linked to the specialisation, aiming, amongst other things, to make the educational project of the school a reality. These suggestions are submitted to the area committee and the committee in charge of educational management. It is made up of all the teachers involved in the training course which corresponds to one or more specialisation(s), and of students representing this or these specialisation(s).

CS CONSEIL SOCIAL

(social services committee)

This committee, presided over by the head of the school, calculates the social services budget and submits it to the public governing body WBE for approval.

In accordance with the approved social services budget, it allocates social benefits, notably individual subsidies to students, which are dealt with anonymously by the committee.

The social services committee is made up of representatives of the three training areas (with teachers and students) and of the school administration.

It also provides an opinion on any question in relation to the social and material conditions of the students.

(student council)

This council is in charge of representing the students of the arts college, defending and promoting their interests in regard to teaching and educational methods, as well as the management of the institution. It incites the students to play an active role and behave responsibly and respectfully within the institution, and more globally, in society.

The student council is made up of student representatives elected each year by the entire ARTS² student community.

LOAN

PÔLE HAINUYER



The <u>Pôle hainuyer</u> groups together all the higher education institutions located within the Hainaut province and includes all types of teaching and networks.


